As you can see from the video Demo's, I have a Prophet 10 by Sequential and you can really get very close with a lot of the Sounds, it's quite remarkable actually.


#### **Presets**

I've named all 100 patches and they are in the order I made them, hence having a number before the name. They have been tagged and have descriptions also. I have gone through the Patches and tried to match the Volume Levels, however this can change drastically depending on if the Mod Wheel and Aftertouch are utilised.

I hope you enjoy using the patches, I've tried to make them musical and dynamic, so you can use them in your Productions, as is. There's only a couple of FX types of Sounds, the rest are all Pads, Strings, Bass Lead and so on.

#### Installation

- 1. Press the "Presets" Button in Repro 5 at the top (next to Tweaks)
- 2. Open the download you got from me and find the Folder "Elements Vol 2 GEOSynths"
- 3. Drag this Folder over to the "User" Folder and that's it.



Patch Name	Туре	Description
1.AlunaGEO	Pad	Beautiful modulated Pad with a fizzy overtone. Becomes brighter with Controllers.
2. Deep End GEO	Lead	Solid Osc Sync Lead, great for low down to, especially when using the MW.
3. At Night GEO	Poly	Bright and cutting Poly, reminiscent of old Electro.
4. At Dave's Pad GEO	Pad	Warm and dark Pad, really cool as a "Bed" underneath Arps and Melodies. Becomes brighter with Controllers.
5. Stringer Things GEO	Strings	Dirty and Broken Stringer Synth. I love making String Synth sounds, they have a great tone and range of uses.
6. Koto GEO	Traditional	Authentic sounding Japanese Koto with lots of dynamics and tone variation
7. Bass Pop GEO	Bass	Short and snappy Bass with tonal variation
8. Marbles GEO	Pad	Rhythmic Pad with a repeating effect which can be slowed down.
9. Snakebite GEO	Lead	Uni Lead with Osc Sync which can be opened up over Octaves.
10. Reversal Pluck GEO	Pluck	Starts as a Pad with a "Reverse" effect, however the shape completely changes with the MW.
11. 80's Funk GEO	Lead	Based this on the kind of sounds that Artists like the SOS Band used. Great for leads, but really good for low end.
12. By The Neck GEO	FX	Vocal sounding poly with lots of modulation. More of a plucky sound with the controllers.
13. Teflon Pad GEO	Pad	Beautiful, sweeping Pad which becomes brighter over time.
14. Fine Keys GEO	Keys	Nice Synthy EP, good over multiple octaves. Added FX with MW.
15. Echo Bass GEO	Bass	Digital Bass with fast rhythm with the MW.
16. Sign of the Tines GEO	Pluck	Plucky, percussive Sound which is great for chords and melodies. Increase FX with MW
17. Power Pluck GEO	Pluck	Big Lead Pluck for Dance Music. MW changes the shape and tone, as well as the PB
18. Cold Snap GEO	Poly	Soft Poly with lovely analog movement and tone. Shape and tone change with the MW.
19. Fallen Star GEO	Poly	Clean and swirling Poly/Pad, can be used for Melodies too. Voice Mod changes with the MW.
20. Fault Line GEO	Bass	Deep Ambient Bass Sequence. Great for Movie and Video work.

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21. Rolling Bass GEO	Bass	Rhythmic Bass with 8th Triplets on the MW.
22. Super Sync GEO	Lead	Typical Oscillator Sync Lead/Bass with rhythmic effect when use Controllers.
23. Childhood GEO	Keys	Lovely Ambient Synth Keys, great for soft melodies and chords. Tonal changes with Controllers.
24. Erased GEO	Pad	Cool SynthPad which can also be used for Melodies. MW changes the tone.
25. Feel Love GEO	Strings	Simple yet beautiful StringPad.
26. Alpha Pad GEO	Pad	Glorious Pad with instant attack, though this can be changed with the PB.
27. Funky Moog GEO	Bass	Huge Lead which splits over the Octaves when using the MW.
28. Pizzy GEO	Poly	Plucked Poly Synth which is great for rhythmic Chords and Melodies.
29. Roland Poly GEO	Poly	Typical Roland Poly/Brass Sound from the 80's. Has a slight pitch on the Attack. MW changes 1 oscillator Pitch by an Octave
30. Sax Me Up GEO	Brass	Authentic Saxophone Patch with varying tonal changes with Velocity and MW.
31. Amped Stringer GEO	Strings	Another cool Stringer Synth, very authentic to old and cheap Stringers.
32. Micro GEO	Poly	Poly which moves over an Octave and has a soft attack when using the MW.
33. Stone GEO	Keys	Cool Filter FM EP. Becomes a pad with the MW.
34. Savage Lands GEO	Pad	Huge atmospheric Pad with lovely tone. MW increases brightness.
35. Winter Chimes GEO	Bell	Great Chimes with lots of dynamics. MW for changing the tone
36. Captured Thoughts GEO	Pad	Modulated SynthPad which has a hard attack, good for quick chord changes.
37. Defender GEO	FX	As a kid, walking into Arcades, this was what i heard coming from every direction :)
38. Heart Stopper GEO	Lead	Huge, Monster of a Lead, especially good low down. Nice subdues tone, while "distorted".
39. Fall GEO Pad		As low, sweeping and growing SynthPad with great depth and movement. MW removes the Resonance for fuller sound.
40. Precision Bass GEO	Bass	Authentic Amped Up Bass with deep tone. Added Chorus with the Controllers.
41. Nylon GEO	Guitar	Acoustic Guitar with great tonal change with the MW.
42. Home Organ GEO	Organ	Cheesy Percussive Organ with brighter tone on MW.
43. Threshold GEO	Lead	Big Bass/Lead which really cuts through, especially when MW is up full!
44. Dark Keys GEO	Keys	Dirty EP which sounds like it's on Vinyl and slightly warped.
45. Jimmy Jam GEO	Bass	Jam & Lewis style Synth Bass.

46. Witness GEO	Poly	Detuned Poly Synth which becomes a Pad.
47. Morph GEO	Pad	Fizzy Pad with lovely overtones which become softer with MW.
48. Safe Zone GEO	Bass	Big, Hollow Bass which is great for House, however push the MW forward for something dirty!
49. Frostbite GEO	Bass	Rhythmic Bass which can also be used as a Lead. Controllers change the tone.
50. Key Zone GEO	Keys	Dirty Synth Keys which are great for Chords and Melodies.
51. Delta Waves GEO	Pad	A bubble and resonant Pad which slowly evolves getting brighter then darker. MW sweeps it down.
52. Golden Pipes GEO	Traditional	Expressive Pan Pipes with good dynamics and tone.
53. Plugged In GEO	Guitar	Distorted Guitar, great for playing 5ths.
54. Faint Echo GEO	Pad	A whimsical PolyPad for light and airy Melodies and Pads.
55. Razor Wire GEO	Lead	Very hard and cutting Lead with tonal changes.
56. Wonder Bass GEO	Bass	Bold and hollow Bass with deep and rich tone.
57. Driven EP GEO	Keys	Bright and modulated EP with a touch of bite.
58. Wayward GEO	Poly	Polysynth with a slightly softer Attack which can also be a Pad as there is a full sustain.
59. Solina Swirl GEO	Strings	Great Stringer Synth sound with movement throughout. You can change the envelope with the MW
60. Stab Sample GEO	Percussive	Metallic percussive sound, which changes by if you keep the ket pressed or release quickly.
61. Dark Earth GEO	Pad	Resonant Pad with lovely tone which can be slightly muted with the MW.
62. Vice GEO	Lead	Lead which can be used for a low Stab also.
63. Lost Juno GEO	Poly	Bright and resonant poly where you can change the shape.
64. Molten Core GEO	Pad	Deep and rich Pad with lots of modulated Delay.
65. Brass 80's GEO	Brass	Modulated Brass with a cheesy tone.
66. Red Line GEO	Poly	Icy and Hard Polysynths, great for both Chords and Melodies.
67. Fulcrum GEO	Bell	Bell tones with lovely decay.
68. Overlord GEO	Bass	Rhythmic Bass/Lead which can be quite aggressive.
69. Terraform GEO	Pad	Thin and wiry Stringpad with varying tone.
70. Altered State GEO	Pad	Deep and Wiry Pad which slowly evolves, though the MW really opens it up.
71. Melodica GEO	Lead	Bright Lead good for picking out melody lines.
72. Pluck Guard GEO	Pluck	Pluck sound with great usage for low end and for poly sounds. Changes to tone with MW.
73. Wetlands GEO	Pad	Pad with slight percussive attack and lots of Reverb.

75. Clean Line GEO  Bass  Bold and Big Bass with no detune. Cuts through really nice.  76. The Grid GEO  Pad  De-rezzed Pad with random overtones and noise. New notes will re-trigger this, though it will get quieter using the MW.  77. Electro Poly GEO  Poly  Bright and cutting Polysynth with thin Body, great for over the top of deep Bass.  Pee Bass with hard attack, though can get quite juicy with the MW.  79. From the Ashes GEO  Pad  Rich Stringpad with vary tone, especially when using the Controllers.  80. Fold GEO  Lead  Huge Lead sound, great for Bass end as well.  81. Time Trip GEO  Pad  Modulated Pad which often breaks up to reveal fast delays. MW to increase LFO to Filter.  82. Neon River GEO  Pad  Bass  Big Bass with nice low end growl. MW will bring in 8th's.  84. Calling GEO  Pad  Wirry Pad with great tone and becomes brighter with the MW and PB.  85. Exomoon GEO  Lead  Wirry Pad with lots of rumbles and movement when using the MW.  86. Magnetic GEO  Lead  Big and bright UNI Lead with subtle detune. Great all over the key range.  87. Night Keys GEO  Bass  Pad  Right Poly with an almost Acoustic quality.  89. Solitude Strings GEO  Pad  Air Stringpad with great with slow movement which becomes brighter with MW.  90. Saturated Bass GEO  Pad  Air Stringer Synth with slow movement which becomes brighter with MW.  91. Orbitalz GEO  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad Bass  Puge saturated Bass which becomes shoter and plucky with MW.  92. Rebellion GEO  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad Pages Bass with nodulated overtones when using the MW.  93. Stand Off GEO  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad  Pad Pad with subtle overtones when using the MW.  94.
